BURNING PERMIT

It is the intent of chapter 33.01 to prescribe regulations consistent with nationally recognized standards for the safeguarding to a reasonable degree of life and property from hazard of fire and explosion arising from the storage, handling and use of hazardous substances, materials and devices and from conditions of hazardous to life, property and the environment in the use or occupancy of buildings or premises. Compliance with codes and standards of the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), State of Wisconsin, or other approved nationally recognized safety standards, as later referred to or as specified in this code, shall be deemed to be prima facie evidence of compliance with this intent.

General Limitations

Open burning is prohibited without first obtaining a Burning Permit. Strictly burning rubbish, leaves, construction waste and other similar material as a means of disposal is prohibited. Burning Permits may be issued by the Clerk subject to notification of the Fire Chief according to the following conditions:

Please initial next to each duty to signify agreement.

_____ Applicant provides their name, address, address where the burning is to be conducted (if different), phone number, date of scheduled burn, approximate time of burn, rainout date of burn and material to be burned.

_____ Burning may only be conducted when wind is calm.

_____ Burning shall be controlled and completed safely.

_____ Fire shall be monitored by applicant at all times.

_____ Burning shall be done at a time and conditions as to cause the least inconvenience to the people in the area.

_____ No burning may be conducted in curbs and/or in the street.

_____ No burning is allowed at any time during drought conditions subject to the discretion of the Fire Chief and Village

_____ A fee may be established by resolution of the Village Board. (\$10.00)

_____ Applicant must notify the Fire Chief by email (cpfirechief@gmail.com) within 24- hours of anticipated burn date/time.
